



SWBA ACHIEVEMENT AWARD NOMINATION – 2017

1. Owner and Exhibitor must be a current member in good standing with ABRA and SWBA to be eligible for the SWBA Achievement Awards. Points will not be calculated until your current year membership is paid. **Please include a copy of your current SWBA Membership card (Owner's & Exhibitor's) with this nomination form.**
2. Nomination is on the horse. In the case of the sale of a nominated horse to another SWBA member during the show season the Achievement Award is earned, the award will go to the current owner on record with ABRA at the time the award was won. It is then the responsibility for the new owner to nominate the horse annually and follow these nomination rules in order for the points to continue to be tracked.
3. There is no required minimum number of SWBA shows to attend per year.
4. Points will be accumulative and carried over from year to year as long as the horse is nominated for that particular year. However, if a horse is not nominated for a certain year, no points will be earned in that year. In order for all previously earned points to be held, the owner of the horse must stay a current member until the award goal is met. You can take as many years as you want to achieve the awards.
5. Nominated horses will receive points using the SWBA point system. Only SWBA & SWBA sponsored shows will count towards this award. Nominated horses can only receive points in ABRA approved classes. No open classes will count.
Points Calculation: Maximum points earned in a class are 6 per judge.

Grand Champion Halter horse will receive an additional two points and the Reserve Champion Halter horse will receive an additional one point.

6. There are no requirements for the type of classes that must be entered for this award. A horse can have points in Halter and/or Performance, or earn all their points showing in one single class. (Example: A Horse that is strictly shown Halter can earn this award with all Halter points.)
7. It is the nominator's responsibility to be familiar with these rules. **Please keep a copy of all nominations for your records.**
8. The Board of Directors will handle all disputes. All decisions of the Board will be final.
9. Please use a separate Nomination Form per horse.
10. **The annual nomination fee is \$20.00.** Nominations will run from January 1st – December 31st. Points will only begin to be tracked when the nomination fee is paid and nominations have to be paid before the horse shows.
