



SOUTHERN WISCONSIN BUCKSKIN ASSOCIATION SHOW RULES FOR ALL SHOWS

ABRA EXHIBITORS:

- ABRA registration papers are required to show your Buckskin, Dun, Grulla or Buckskin Bred horse.
- A copy of the horse's ABRA registration papers (front and back), the Owner's ABRA membership card (front and back), and the Exhibitor's ABRA membership card (front and back) are to be submitted with the show entry form.
- All ABRA exhibitors must have their original ABRA registration papers to verify current ownership of their horse and their ABRA membership cards at the show.
- To be eligible to compete in the Performance Horse Halter classes, a Register of Merit in performance must be earned and recorded on the horse's record. Proof of Register of Merit **MUST** be provided to show management and a copy of the certificate must be left at the show office. A performance Register of Merit must be earned in the division in which it is to compete (i.e. Amateur division, the performance Register of Merit must have been earned in the Amateur division.)
- A horse may not enter their age division halter class and the performance halter class on the same day of the show in a particular division. (i.e. may not enter Amateur Halter Mares and Amateur Performance Halter Mares on the same day of the show.)

ALL BREED EXHIBITORS:

- All Breed classes are open to all breeds and any color of horse or pony.
- Non-ABRA horse entries do not require registration papers unless showing in an age specific class (i.e. All Breed 2 & Under Halter, All Breed 2 & Under Longe Line, etc.) however, all of the horse's information does need to be on the entry form.

ALL BREED TINY TOT & ALL BREED LEADLINE CLASSES:

- All Breed Tiny Tot classes are open to exhibitors 10 & under and cannot enter any canter classes.
- All Breed Leadline classes are open to exhibitors 8 & under and cannot enter any other riding class.

SPECIAL TRAINING CLASS: We will have a Training Class each day after the Leadline class open to ABRA and All Breed horses. This will not be judged but will have an announcer call the class like normal. This is a fundraiser for the club and will cost \$3.00, which can be paid at the gate or put on your tab.

CLASS FEES: All ABRA entry fees are per horse, per judge, each day. \$6.00 per class per judge for ABRA classes and they will have 3 judges. All of the All Breed classes are \$5.00 per judge. The All Breed classes will also have 3 judges. The All Breed classes are open to all breeds of horses and ponies.

!!!!SPECIAL UNLIMITED FEE!!!!

ABRA HORSES – JULY 8&9 & SEPTEMBER 9&10 SHOW - We are offering an Unlimited Fee of \$225.00 for the entire weekend which includes any and all ABRA classes. The unlimited fee is based on per horse, not horse/rider combination. The unlimited fee would be for people that are showing in 7 or more ABRA classes per day. Anything under that you would pay the individual class fees. If you are showing under the Unlimited Fee you can cross over into another ABRA division at no additional cost. (Example: If a mother is showing the horse in ABRA Amateur and the daughter is showing the same horse in ABRA Youth it would only cost one Unlimited Fee). Any All Breed classes will be \$5.00 additional per class/per judge, you cannot crossover into All Breed classes for the ABRA Unlimited fee.

ABRA HORSES – JUNE 9-11 SHOW - We are offering an Unlimited Fee of \$295.00 for the entire weekend which includes any and all ABRA classes. The unlimited fee is based on per horse, not horse/rider combination. The flat rate fee would be for people that are showing in 7 or more ABRA classes per day. Anything under that you would pay the individual class fees. If you are showing under the Unlimited Fee you can cross over into another ABRA division at no additional cost. (Example: If a mother is showing the horse in ABRA Amateur and the daughter is showing the same horse in ABRA Youth it would only cost them one Unlimited Fee). Any All Breed classes will be \$5.00 additional per class/per judge, you cannot crossover into All Breed classes for the ABRA Unlimited fee.

ALL BREED HORSES – JULY 8&9 & SEPTEMBER 9&10 SHOW – We are offering an Unlimited Fee of \$135.00 for the entire weekend which includes any and all All Breed classes. The unlimited fee is based on per horse, not horse/rider combination. The flat rate fee would be for people that are showing in 8 or more All Breed classes per day. Anything under that you would pay the individual class fees. If you are showing under the Unlimited Fee you can cross over into another All Breed division at no additional cost. (Example: If a mother is showing the horse in All Breed Open classes and the daughter is showing the same horse in All Breed Tiny Tot it would only cost one Unlimited Fee).

ALL BREED HORSES – JUNE 9,10,11 SHOW - We are offering an Unlimited Fee of \$225.00 for the entire weekend which includes any and all All Breed classes. The unlimited fee is based on per horse, not horse/rider combination. The flat rate fee would be for people that are showing in 8 or more All Breed classes per day. Anything under that you would pay the individual class fees. If you are showing under the Unlimited Fee you can cross over into another All Breed division at no additional cost. (Example: If a mother is showing the horse in All Breed Open classes and the daughter is showing the same horse in All Breed Tiny Tot it would only cost one Unlimited Fee).

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS:

- **Pre-Entry Deadline: 3 Days Before Each Show.** No Payment is required with your entries, only the completed entry form. You can add or cancel classes when you arrive at the show. Pre-entering will save you and the office time. If you Pre-Enter your name will be put into a drawing for a free stall to be announced at the show.
- **STALL RESERVATIONS FOR JUNE & JULY SHOWS IN JEFFERSON, WI**
Stalls must be reserved in advance. Please see the stall reservation form on the website and mail or email to stalls@swbuckskin.com. Stall fees for the June show are \$75.00 (which includes 2 bags of shavings) for the weekend for a horse stall and \$65.00 per tack stall. Stall fees for the July show are \$65.00 (which includes 2 bags of shavings) for the weekend for a horse stall and \$55.00 per tack stall. Additional shavings are available also at \$7.00 per bag. Note: Stalls are cement. Day stalls are \$25.00 per day if available (no overnight). Jump Out fee for non-stalled horses is \$15.00 per day. Horses may arrive after 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday night for the June Show and after 6:00 p.m. Thursday night for the July Show, No exceptions! Wednesday night arrivals for the June Show and Thursday night arrivals for the July Show pay an extra \$12.00.
- **STALL RESERVATIONS FOR SEPTEMBER 9&10 SHOW IN ELKHORN, WI - Stalls must be reserved in advance. Please see the stall reservation form on the website and mail or email to stalls@swbuckskin.com. Stall fees are \$65.00 for the weekend. Day stalls are \$25.00 per day if available (no overnight). Shavings are available for \$7.00 per bag. Horses may arrive after 9:00 a.m. on Friday, No exceptions!**
- A copy of your horse's current Negative Coggins is required.
- A copy of current 30-day Interstate Health papers is required for all out-of-state horses.
- January 1, 2017 is the cutoff date for age specific classes for both horses and exhibitors.
- Youth exhibitors are not allowed to show stallions.
- All judging decisions are final.
- Entries close when preceding class enters the ring.
- Refunds will only be given for scratches if notified 3 classes before.
- The Show Manager/Show Secretary reserves the right to combine, split or cancel any class in keeping with the shows best interest.
- All minors must have a parent or guardian sign their release form on the entry form.
- Any exhibitor without a number or an incorrect number shall be disqualified.
- Back numbers are randomly assigned to each exhibitor. If you use a certain number and it is not already taken you are only then allowed to use it. Please list your preferred number on the entry form and if it is available you will be able to use it.

- All exhibitors have exactly 2 minutes to enter the ring once the class has been called and the gate has been opened. No exhibitor will be allowed to enter the show ring after the gate is closed. The Gate person has the right to refuse entry to any exhibitor who exceeds this time limit.
- A tack change must be requested at the gate at least 3 classes prior to the class in which the change is needed. A maximum of 3 minutes will be allowed after the tack change is announced.
- The patterns for Showmanship, Equitation, Horsemanship, Reining and Trail Classes will be posted at least 1 hour before the class.
- Bits and other equipment will be checked at the judge's discretion for ABRA and All Breed horses.
- ABRA rules shall apply for both ABRA and All Breed horses. When ABRA is silent then AQHA rules apply.
- You need not be a member of SWBA to show or qualify for the weekend High-Point Awards.
- No entries or fees will be refunded without a veterinarian excuse.
- Any exhibitor wishing to start a tab at the show office will be required to leave a signed check at the office or pay cash for your entries.
- All dogs must be kept on a leash. No loose dogs allowed!
- No bikes, skateboards or rollerblading in the barns at any time.
- No smoking allowed in any of the buildings.
- No cooking of food allowed in the barns.

ALL AROUND WEEKEND HIGH-POINT RULES:

- There will be no fee for All Around High-Points. Everyone's points will be tracked, no need to sign up.
- High-Point is based on 1 rider/1 horse combination. Except ABRA Open & All Breed Open Horses where the points go with the horse.
- A tiebreaker judge will be randomly selected to break any ties.
- You do not need to show all weekend to qualify.
- High-Point contenders will accumulate points from each judge in the following designated High-Point classes for their division.

Points are calculated from each judge for all awards as follows-Grand Champion Halter horses will receive an additional 2 points and the Reserve Champion Halter horse will receive an additional 1 point

INDIVIDUAL CLASS PRIZES:

- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 6th place in all ABRA classes and will be available for pickup at the show office.
- Award for 1st place and ribbons 2nd -6th place will be awarded in the All Breed classes.

ALL AROUND WEEKEND HIGH-POINT PRIZES:

- A High-Point and Reserve High-Point award will be presented to the two top point earners in each of the 10 divisions.
- Awards to be presented after the show on the last day of the show weekend.

CIRCUIT AWARDS WILL BE GIVEN OUT AT THE JUNE SHOW FOR EACH CLASS:

- A High-Point and Reserve High-Point Circuit Award for each class will be presented to the two top point earners.

These rules are subject to change at any time up to and including the day of the show with or without further notice. Exhibitors and owners agree to abide by all the rules and regulations above by signing the entry form. Any unsigned entry form will not be accepted.
